## OUR HAIR, MAKE UP AND JEWELLERY REGULATIONS

### Hair

- Stud Earrings (a maximum of one in each ear lobe)

The first letter tells you which wing the classroom is in. B = Bredon, M = Malvern, C = Cleeve

The next letter/number tells you the floor. G = Ground, 1 = first, 2 = second

The final two numbers tell you which classroom, from 01 to 07.
